ESPN EVENTS ANNOUNCES FUTURE VEGAS KICKOFF CLASSIC MATCHUPS

ESPN Events has announced a pair of future Vegas Kickoff Classic games at Allegiant Stadium that will feature matchups of top FCS programs from the Big Sky Conference and Missouri Valley Football Conference.

Two Vegas Kickoff Classic games will now be contested during Labor Day weekend in 2027. A historic, first-time matchup of Miami (Fla.) vs. Utah – billed as the "Battle of the U" – was previously announced and will take place on Saturday, September 4. That game will now be preceded by another neutral-site matchup earlier that weekend when 18-time national champion North Dakota State meets three-time national champion Montana State in Las Vegas.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

Each month, we will highlight a former standout player from the Las Vegas Bowl and what that player has accomplished since making his mark in the Las Vegas Bowl.

In 2010, **Kellen Moore** led Boise State to a 26-3 rout of Utah in the Maaco Las Vegas Bowl at Sam Boyd Stadium. Moore passed for 339 yards and two touchdowns and was named the game's MVP while guiding Chris Petersen's squad to a commanding victory over its southern rival. In recognition of his performance and career achievements, Moore was inducted into the Las Vegas Bowl Hall of Fame in 2021.

Following his career at Boise State, Moore spent six years as a backup quarterback in the NFL with Detroit and Dallas before transitioning to quarterbacks coach in Dallas in 2018. In 2019, he was promoted to offensive coordinator for the Cowboys and held that position for four seasons. After one season as offensive coordinator for the Chargers, he transitioned to Philadelphia and guided the Eagles to a win in Super Bowl LIX over Kansas City.

On Feb. 11. Moore was named head coach of the New Orleans Saints.
